Arnold Gesell: Maturationist

The Maturational Theory of Child Development was developed by Gesell.

His theory focuses on physical and mental development. Gesell believed developmental patterns are determined by child's heredity.

The Maturational Theory is based on three assumptions:

1. Development has a biological basis
2. Good and bad years alternate
3. Body types (endomorph, ectomorph and mesomorph) share a connection with personality development

According to this theory, children are expected to show certain behaviors according to a maturational timetable.
