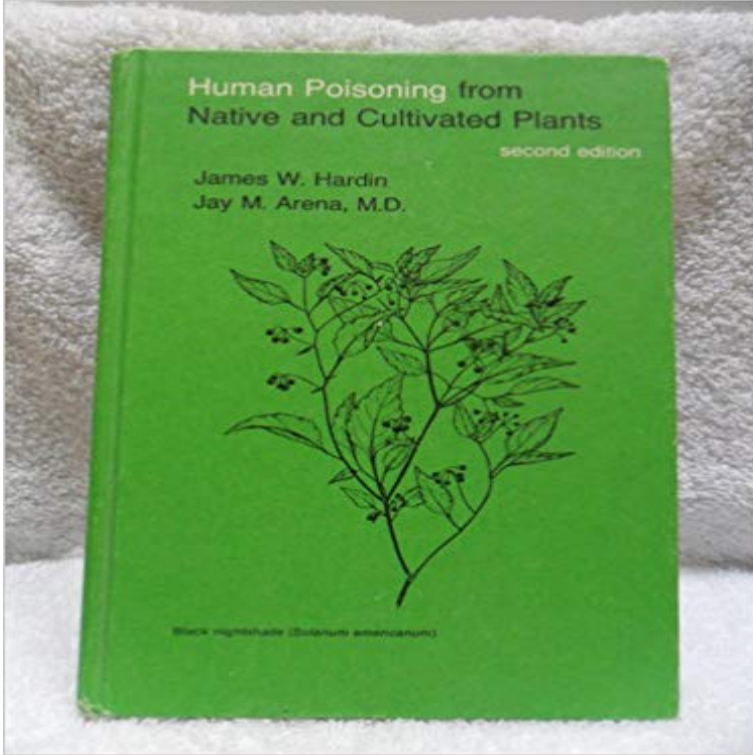


Human Poisoning from Native and Cultivated Plants
