Surface Survey of Woodrow Ruin, Grant County, New Mexico

Woodrow Ruin is a large, multi-component Mimbres site located in the upper Gila valley. Although scholars have mentioned Woodrow Ruin for over 80 years, little professional research has been performed there. During the summer of 2011 researchers from the University of Colorado, Arizona State University, Museum of New Mexico, and Desert Archaeology conducted research at Woodrow Ruin. The research consisted of a surface ceramic survey and high-contour GPS mapping, and was the most extensive to date at the site. This article examines the history of research at Woodrow Ruin, describes current work at the site, and suggests that Woodrow Ruin can help elucidate some long-standing issues in Mimbres archaeology.

El sitio de Woodrow Ruin es un gran sitio de varios componentes localizado en la parte superior del Valle de Gila. Mientras que este sitio ha sido mencionado en la literatura arqueológica por más de 80 años, el sitio ha sido propenso a muy pocas investigaciones profesionales. Durante el verano del 2011 investigadores de University of Colorado, Arizona State University, Museum of New Mexico, y Desert Archaeology condujeron un reconocimiento de superficie en busca de cerámicas y un mapeo de GPS de alto contorno. Hasta la fecha, estas investigaciones han sido las más extensivas que se han hecho en este sitio. Este artículo examina la historia de las investigaciones hechas en Woodrow Ruin, describe el trabajo hecho en el sitio, y provee sugerencias sobre como Woodrow Ruin puede aclarar muchas de las dudas que todavía se tienen sobre la región arqueológica de Mimbres.

Introduction

Woodrow Ruin is one of the two largest archaeological sites in the upper Gila River valley, one of the largest sites in the Mimbres region overall (Figure 1), and is one of the few remaining well-preserved Mimbres sites. Like most Mimbres sites, looting
